Through the seasons

Embark on a seasonal journey with Amanoi, and discover the wildly differing characters of the splendid Nui Chua National Park, one of Vietnam's biggest preserves of both land and marine habitats.

The climate in Vietnam differs from the North to the South, with Ninh Thuan province obtaining unique weather and distinctive vegetation which cannot be found anywhere else in the country.

Situated in the south central coast of Vietnam, Nui Chua National Park in Ninh Thuan province is a very special conservative site which contains unique semi-arid vegetation and sea turtle nesting beaches. This 29,000 ha area preserves an immense intact biodiversity, including the marine habitats with coral reefs of Vinh Hy, one of Vietnam's most beautiful bays. This region has the least amount of rain and the most sunny days throughout the country. Dry season takes place for nearly 8 months full of sunshine while the rest of the year observes rainy and windy weather.

Visit March to September

The sapphire ocean is a perfect reflection of the crystal blue sky and fluffy clouds. Magnificent rolling hills which uncover the unique rock formations open up a breathtaking and exceptional scenery of the untouched wilderness.

Temperatures range between 25 to 33C (77 to 91F) with hot sunny days and cooler at night with ocean breezes. The 250 days of sunshine annually is ideal to enjoy water sports at Amanoi's private beach such as water skiing, Hobie Cat sailing or discover the underwater world of 307 coral varieties with snorkeling. This is also the fishing season, so don't miss our boat cruise to visit the fishermen and bargain for a catch of the day which will then be well prepared for your fresh seafood BBQ dinner by our chefs. Trek in the national park or right onsite the property is a great way to discover the flora and fauna biodiversity of thorny and cactus family plants, watch 181 bird species and appreciate the impressive wildlife and landscape.

Visit October to February

The dramatic mountain ranges turn evergreen while the forest's inhabitants refresh and drench themselves in the lush showers and mild weather.

Temperatures are between 21 to 27C (70 to 80F) with rain intervals mostly in October and November and windy season is until February. Enjoy a full-day spa programme to relax and recharge your energy with Amanoi signature massage, scented bath, body ritual and facial care. For a holistic experience, unwind in the exclusive Spa Houses with private facilities and therapists to rejuvenate the body and soul with Morrocan Hammam or contemporary Banya treatment. Explore Amanoi

Set high on a wide promontory, Amanoi lies 55 kilometres south of Cam Ranh Airport in a region renowned for its spectacular mountain and coastal scenery.

Combining the Sanskrit-derived word for 'peace' with *noi*, meaning 'place' in Vietnamese, Amanoi is a contemporary beachside resort with 13 guest Pavilions, 16 Villas with private pools, five Residences and two Spa Houses. Overlooking Vinh Hy Bay on Vietnam's dramatic central coast, the property is embraced by Nui Chua National Park and features a lakeside Aman Spa. Magnificent views unfold from the spectacular hilltop infinity pool and the Central Pavilion, which houses the Restaurant, Bar and library.
